- Abstract should not be more than 250 words.(Excluding title,author and institutional affiliations.)
- Abstract and original articles should be structured as:Objectives,Methods,Results and Conclusions.
- All Abstracts for oral paper presentations will be scrutinised by the VAPM committee and accepted abstracts will be informed by email.

## **Instructions for Preparation for Oral Papers during VAPCON 2019**

- The sessions have been divided according to the system and the judges for the session have been selected accordingly
- The Session timings will be emailed to you and will also be available on website..
- The delegates are requested to strictly stick to the time limits to ensure that the programs proceed as per schedule. The time allotted for each presentation is 7 min + 1 min for discussion. Watch will appear on the screen so the presenter will have to stick to the time limits. In addition, a short single and two long warning bells will ring at 6 min and 7 mins respectively to warn the speakers.
- Please load your presentations well in time.
- The certificates will be presented at the end of each oral session.
- The Power Point presentations should be made in Microsoft Power Point format.
- The preferred headings will be Background, Aims, Materials and Methods, Result and Discussion, Conclusions.
- The font size for the title should be 32/36 and for the main text should be 24/28. Preferably use only Times New Roman or Arial font.
- The first slide should clearly indicate The Abstract No (OP1 / OP70 etc...), Title, Author(s) and Institution(s). The Presenting Author should be highlighted in Bold
- Please use PowerPoint friendly colour schemes with adequate contrast of background and text in such a way that it is easily readable in a bright room with day light.
