

- Poster size: Width (3 Ft) x (4 Ft) Portrait / vertical orientation.
- Top of the poster should indicate Title, Author(s) and Institution(s).
- Presenting author's name has to be underlined.
- Poster presentation should include following titles
 - o Original Papers: Background, Methods, Results and Conclusions.
 - Case Report(s), it should include Background, Case History and Conclusion.
- The material should be well labelled and legible from a distance of up to 2.5 meters. Avoid use of fancy fonts.
- The material should be well labelled and legible from a distance of up to 2.5 meters. Avoid use of fancy fonts. Use upper and lowercase letters. Use only Times New Roman or Arial font. The text, tables and graphics should look integrated.
- Gross and photomicrographs should have good contrast and sharp focus. All photos should have legends.
- References should be written at the bottom in small font size.
- Poster numbering Your poster should mention the Poster number in large font on the top right corner.
- You will find the number of your poster in the confirmation of acceptance email forwarded to you.
- You will be allocated a poster panel which will have your poster number on it.
